



Uniform Infraction

Stockton 2012-2013

- Students at Stockton should be in uniform, unless otherwise required. Uniforms are:
 - White/light blue/dark blue shirts—plain except for Stockton logos
 - Dark blue bottoms—skirts, shorts, pants, sweatpants
- It is the responsibility of the homeroom teacher to enforce Stockton's Uniform policy.
- Students who are in uniform may be given PAWS for demonstrating expected behavior.

Consequences for lack of uniform may include having the homeroom teacher:

- Request student to change into a Stockton shirt. Homeroom teachers may be given some shirts at the beginning of the year for students to use, if shirts are available.
- Contact parent/guardian to inform them of the uniform code infraction, using the Uniform Infraction Notice #1.
- Request the student refrains from extra-curricular activities if the student is chronically out of uniform. Contact the parent/guardian to inform them of chronic uniform infractions using Uniform Infraction Notice #2.
